RE/MAX Retains Top Spot in McHenry County Sales

The RE/MAX Northern Illinois network remained the market-share leader in McHenry County during 2006. RE/MAX agents listed 26.1 percent of all homes sold in the county based on sales data available through the Multiple Listing Service of Northern Illinois (MLSNI).

Home sales reported by the MLSNI totaled 4,968 in McHenry County during 2006, a decrease 14.3 percent from the 5,799 homes sold during the prior year.

The top 5 real estate organizations in McHenry County during 2006, in terms of sold listings, were

RE/MAX with 1,295 (26.1 percent), Coldwell Banker with 722 (14.5 percent), Century 21 with 583 (11.7 percent), Prudential with 511 (10.3 percent) and Baird & Warner with 297 (6 percent).

During 2006, RE/MAX ranked as Chicagoland's market-share leader listing 20.8 percent of all homes sold. RE/MAX has held that leadership position for each of the 12 years since the MLSNI first made market-share data available. RE/MAX also continues to lead the suburban Chicago area, closing 26.1 percent of listings sold in 2006.

RE/MAX offices lead in general real estate sales across Northern Illinois and have been number one in residential sales in the Chicago metropolitan area since 1989.

In 2006, RE/MAX Northern Illinois had closed sales volume of more than \$15 billion.
